# Introduction

Introducing WP member Site. The Wordpress Membership Site plugin that allows you to quickly and easily turn your Wordpress Blog into a recurring income machine. Charge your members a monthly fee and watch your Paypal account expand with cash on a monthly basis.

## Some of the features and benefits of WP Member Site include:

- The ability to charge one-time or recurring monthly fees.
- The ability to set your membership price.
- Full integration with the Wordpress User management system.
- The ability to tag text to make portions of posts and pages visible to non-paying members as teaser text.
- A payment page that you can redirect user to from teaser pages, the generic registration page, or by sending the actual page link.

If you visit <http://wpmembersite.com/please-pay-for-the-content-first> you'll see an example of the payment page you will be setting up for your members to register.

If you visit <http://wpmembersite.com/test-post-2/> you will see an example of how all posts are protected, and how register and login links are presented to non-members trying to view content.

You'll also notice "This is some teaser text..." written on **Test-Post-2**. This is text that is contained in special `[tag] begin read [/tag]` and `[tag] end read [/tag]` tags allowing you to specify what is visible to anybody who visits your site and is not a member.

## New in Version 3.0

- The ability to select a global setting **Hide all content (default)** or **View all content**.

The 'Hide all content' setting is the same default setting the previous version of the plugin had. All content is hidden by default, and only content contained in the `[tag] begin read [/tag]` and `[tag] end read [/tag]` tags is *revealed* to non-logged in users. A message is placed in each post saying 'This is only an excerpt of the post. To access the entire contents of this post, please **login** or click **here** to Register.'

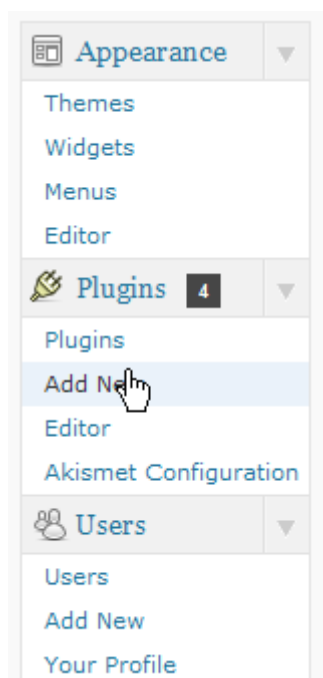
The 'View all content' setting shows all content on the blog by default. Only content contained in the `[tag] begin read [/tag]` and `[tag] end read [/tag]` tags is *hidden* from non-logged in users. For posts where some content is hidden with the tags, a message is placed in each post saying 'This is only an excerpt of the post. To access the entire contents of this post, please **login** or click **here** to Register.'

# Installation

1. Log into your Wordpress installation as an Administrator:



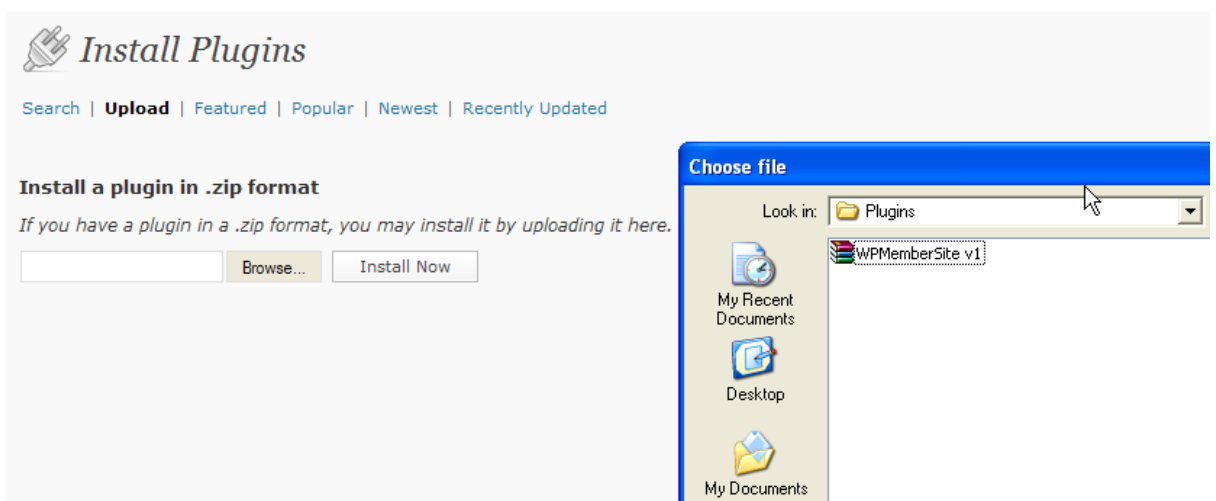
2. Click on 'Plugins' > 'Add New' in the left-hand menu:



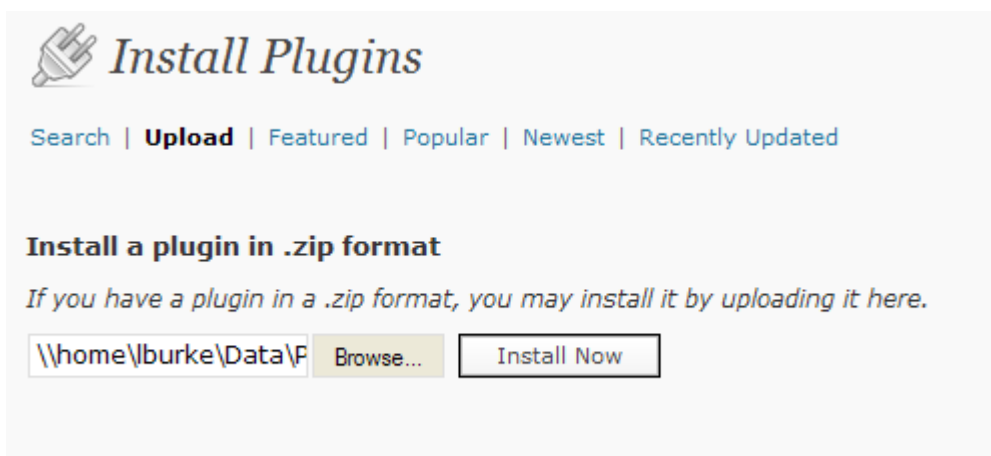
3. Click on 'Upload' from the top menu:



4. Click 'Browse', navigate to where you saved the plugin, select the file and click 'Open':



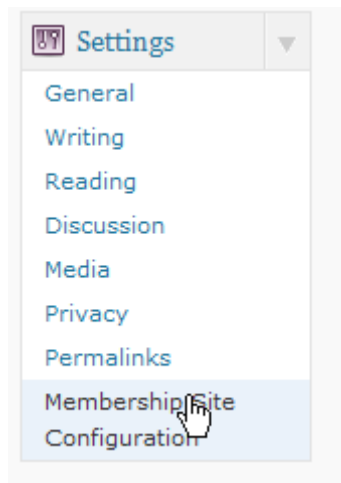
5. Click 'Install Now':



6. Once the installation is complete, click 'Activate Plugin':

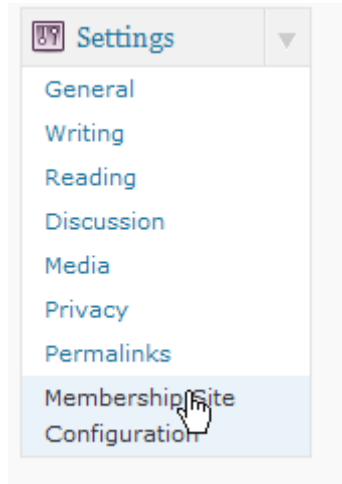


7. You now need to configure your plugin. Under 'Settings' on the left-hand menu, you will now have a 'Membership Site Configuration' option. Click this, and move to the next section of this Documentation:



# Configuration

1. To configure WP Member Site, click 'Membership Site Configuration' under 'Settings' on the left-hand menu:



2. You will be presented with the WP Member Site Configuration screen:

Setup Your PayPal IPN Your Notification URL should be:

PayPal Email Address  Enter your Paypal email here  
Input your paypal email address.

Item Name  Give your membership an item name, number, payment amount and currency code. These are used by Paypal IPN.  
The name of the service to be shown on the PayPal order form when your client purchases a membership.

Item Number  The number for your membership service, this can be any number and is just used for tracking purposes.

Payment Amount  The payment amount, for a one-time payment or per period for recurring payments.  
Example: 1.00

Currency Code  The currency code. Example: USD

Payment Period (days)  If your membership is recurring, select a period - e.g. 30 days.  
The number of days between recurring payments.  
Example: 30


Payment method  One time  Recurring  
Decide whether you want a one-time or recurring membership payment option.  
Please select a payment method. The default is 'one time'.

User Message  After you register, you will be redirected to the Paypal payment site where you can pay for your new membership. After payment you will have  
A message that will be displayed on the user registration page informing them that they will be redirected to the Paypal payment page for payment after they register.

User Payment  You need to create this page and place the <!-- go paypal --> code on it.  
The page where your client will be redirected after registering to pay for their membership.

Hide all content (default)  View all content  
Decide whether you want to 'Hide all' or 'View all' content by default.

4. First, input your 'Paypal Email Address', and give your membership an 'Item Name', 'Item Number', 'Payment Amount' and 'Currency Code':




Payment method  One time  Recurring

5. You will also need to select whether you want to charge a 'One time' access fee for your blog, or a 'Recurring' fee. If you select 'Recurring', please input the 'Payment Period' in days.
6. The 'User Message' is what gets displayed at [www.YourDomain..com//wp-login.php?action=register](http://www.YourDomain..com//wp-login.php?action=register) . You can customise this as required.





7. This is how the 'User Message' will appear at [www.YourDomain.com/wp-login.php?action=register](http://www.YourDomain.com/wp-login.php?action=register) (in red):



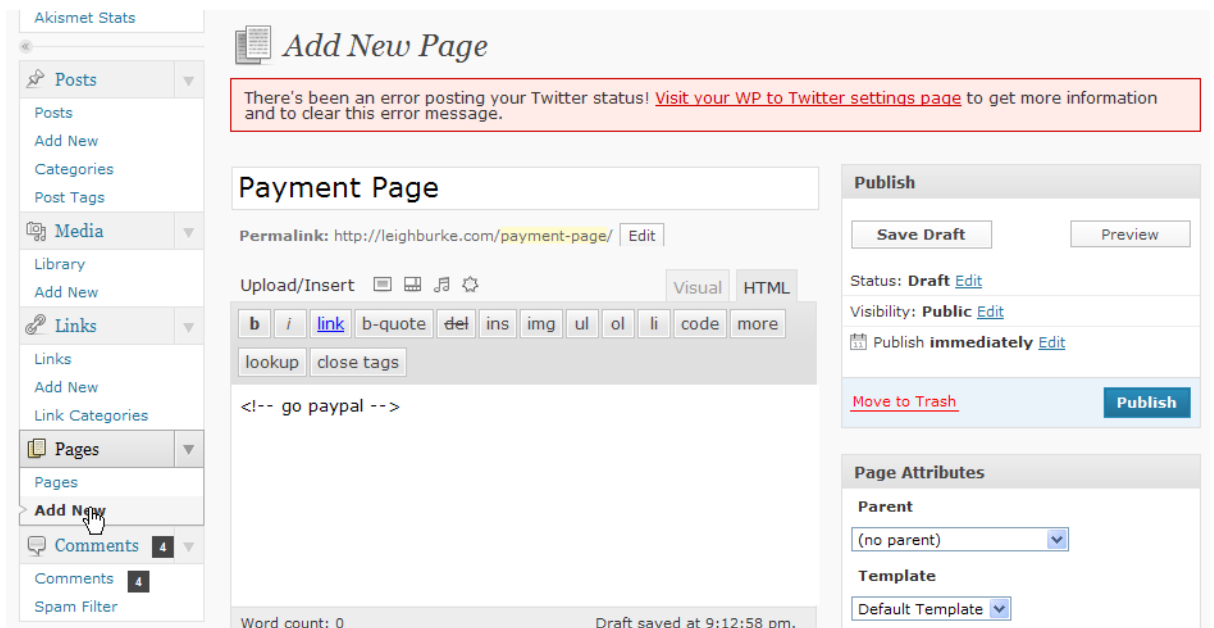

8. For the 'User Payment' page, you need to create this page within Wordpress. You can call this page anything you want. Once you have created the page, paste the full URL for the page in here:

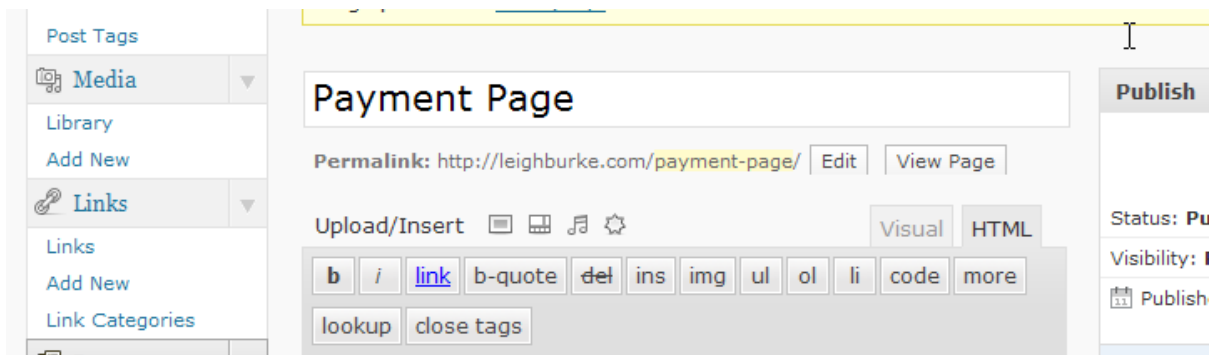

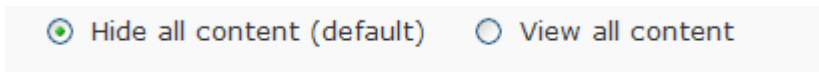
9. To create your 'User Payment' page, click 'Pages' > 'Add New'. Give your new page a name. Be sure that the 'HTML' tab is selected, then paste this code into your page `<!-- go paypal -->` Then click 'Publish':



10. Once your page is published, you will see a 'Permalink'. Highlight this link with your mouse, select CTRL + C to copy the link, then press CTRL + V to paste it in the 'User Payment' section described in **Step 8**:




11. Lastly you will need to decide whether you want to 'Hide all' or 'View all' content by default.

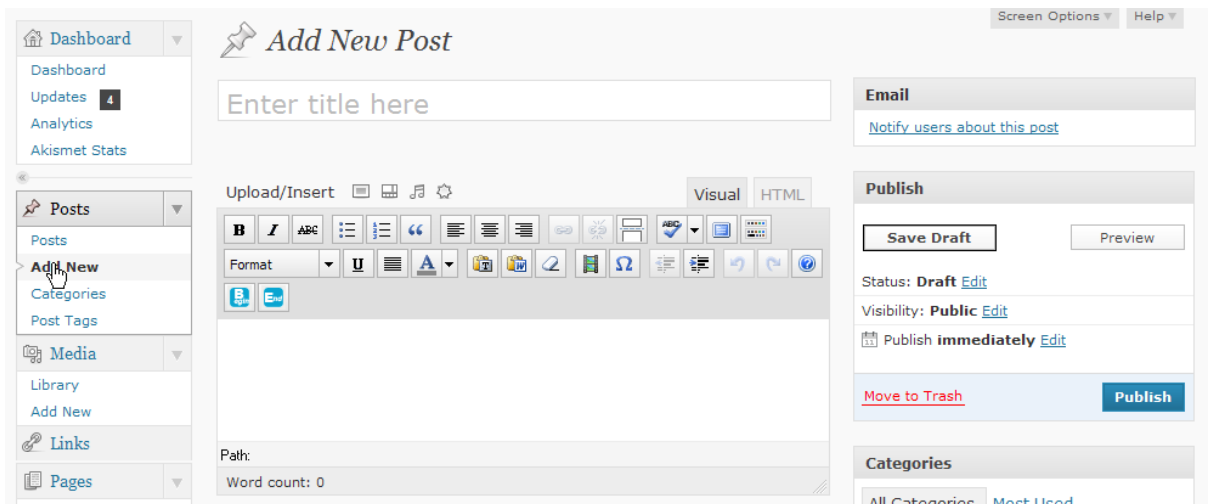


With the 'Hide all content' setting enabled, all content is hidden by default, and only content contained in the `[tag] begin read [/tag]` and `[tag] end read [/tag]` tags is *revealed* to non-logged in users. A message is placed in each post saying 'This is only an excerpt of the post. To access the entire contents of this post, please [login](#) or click [here](#) to Register.'

The 'View all content' setting shows all content on the blog by default. Only content contained in the `[tag] begin read [/tag]` and `[tag] end read [/tag]` tags is *hidden* from non-logged in users. For posts where some content is hidden with the tags, a message is placed in each post saying 'This is only an excerpt of the post. To access the entire contents of this post, please [login](#) or click [here](#) to Register.'

12. When creating a New Post, click 'Posts' > 'Add New'. You will notice 2 new icons on the

toolbar . The first icon inserts the `[tag] begin read [/tag]` tag, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> icon inserts the `[tag] end read [/tag]` tag. The functionality of these varies depending on whether the global 'Hide all content' or 'View all content' setting is selected (**see 11 above**). If using the 'HTML' tab, you can type these codes in manually or cut and paste them:



13. WP Member Site has a 'Test Mode' that will allow you to test the plugin with Paypal without actually making any payment. To use test mode, select the check-box 'Check this to select test mode'. You will need to have a Paypal test account, you can click the link to sign-up free. You will then need to click the 'Test PayPal IPN' link to setup your IPN. Your Notification URL is supplied by the plugin below:



Setup Your PayPal IPN Your Notification URL should be: Highlight this URL, and copy and paste it to the 'Instant Payment Notification (IPN) URL:' field when setting up your Instant Payment Notification.

PayPal will send transaction details back by IPN, You will need to set this up to confirm transactions.

Once you have completed your testing, you will need to deselect the 'Check this to select test mode' check-box, and setup your 'Real PayPal IPN'. First, highlight and copy (CTRL-C) your IPN URL (shown in the screenshot above), then click the 'Real PayPal IPN' link to be taken to the right area within Paypal.

PayPal sends IPN messages to the URL that you specify below.

To start receiving IPN messages, enter the notification URL and select **Receive IPN messages** below. To temporarily stop receiving IPN messages, select **Do not receive IPN messages** below. PayPal continues to generate and store IPN messages until you select **Receive IPN messages** again (or turn off IPN).

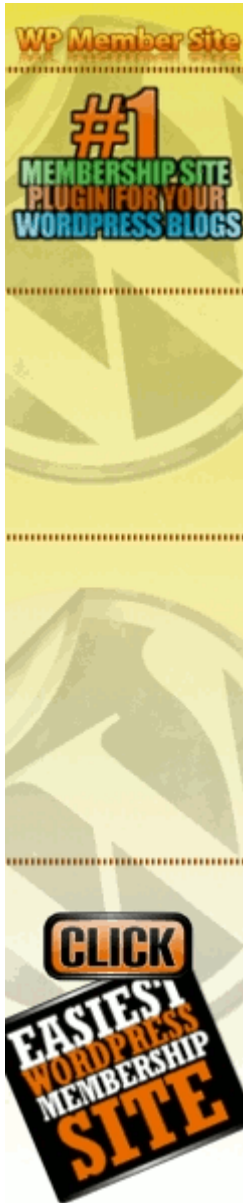

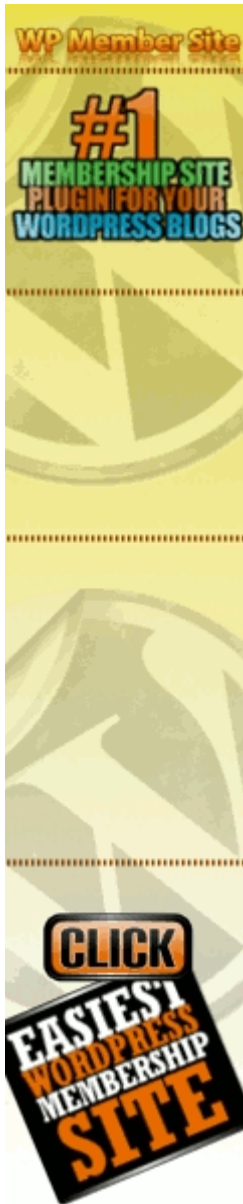
